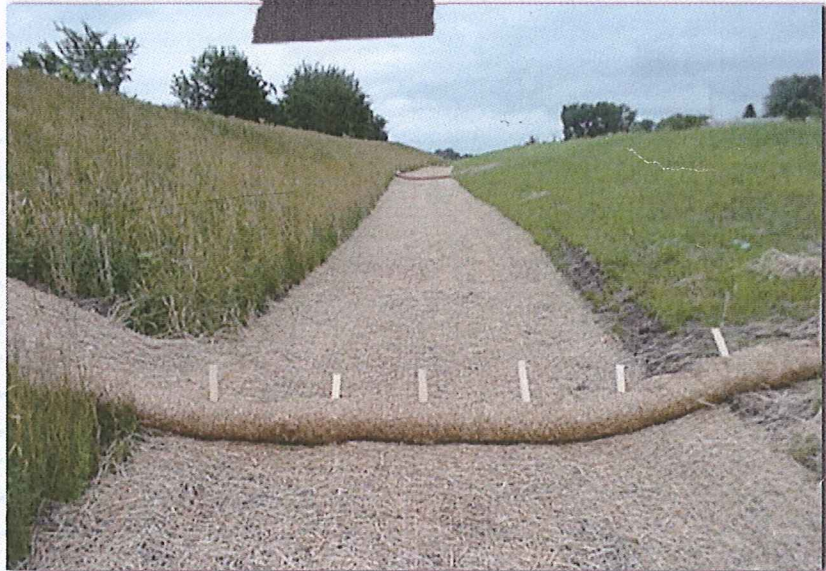
TIPPECANOE COUNTY PARTNERSHIP FOR WATER QUALITY
